This Indenture made this Eleventh Day of February one thousand seven hundred and Seventy Nine Between Benjamin Worrell of Southampton County and Colony of Virginia of the one part and Elijah Worrell of the said County of the other part witnesses that the said Benjamin Worrell the Receipt whereof the said Benjamin Worrell doth hereby acknowledge, hath Granted Sold Enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain Sell Enfeoff and confirm unto the said Elijah Worrell his heirs and assigns forever one certain Tract or parcel of Land lying being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation two hundred acres let the same be more or less and bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a gum in the Cypress Swamp thence up the run of the said Swamp to a gum thence by a line of marked Trees to a turkey Oak in Josiah Worrells line thence by the line Joseph Worrells line to a pine in the head of the head of the Hogpen Branch thence by William Vicks line and by Lewis Vicks line to the Beginning with all Trees woods underwoods commons common of profit profits Commodities advantages emoluments and hereditaments and also the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents Services of the premises and also whatsoever to the plantation or Tract of Land belonging or in any wise appurtenant or upon the same grows or happens or arises on the premises and Every part thereof and also all the estate Right Title Interest Claims and Demand whatsoever of him the said Benjamin Worrell of in and to the said premises and Every part thereof To have and to hold all and singular the said premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the Elijah Worrell his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Elijah Worrell his Heirs and assigns forever and the said Benjamin Worrell for him and his Heirs the said plantation and premises and every part thereof against him and his heirs and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever unto the said Elijah Worrell his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever Defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Benjamin Worrell hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his Seal the Day and Year above Written
