This Indenture made this Eleventh day of February one thousand seven hundred and seventy Nine Between Matthew Vick Senior of the Colony of Virginia and County of Southampton of the one part and Council Vick of the said place of the other part Witnesseth that the said Matthew Vick Senior for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings Current Money of Virginia to him in hand by the said Council Vick the receipt whereof the said Matthew Vick Senior doth hereby Acknowledge, hath Granted bargained Sold, Enfeoffed, and confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain, Sell, enfeoff, and Confirm unto the said Council Vick his heirs and Assigns forever, one certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid Containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth (to wit) beginning at a maple in the Murtle Branch thence by William Vicks line to a pine thence by a line of marked trees to a pine in James Atkinsons line thence by the said Atkinsons line and by William Thomas's line to a pine a corner of William Vicks line thence by his line to the Murtle Branch thence up the run of the said Branch to the beginning with all Trees woods under woods Commons Common of pastures profits Commodities advantages emblements Hereditaments and also the Reversion Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents Services of the premises and also whatsoever to the plantation or tract of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining or upon the same grows happens or arises on the premises and every part thereof and also all the estate Right Title Interest Claim & Demand
