 Enfeoff and confirm unto the said Moses Kenney one certain tract or parcel
 of land situate lying and being in the said County of Southampton and on the
 South Side of the three creeks containing as is estimation one hundred acres
 be the same more or less and is bounded as follows (to wit) beginning at a pine
 an elbow in Samuel Westbrooks line at the head of the deep bottoms thence along
