This Indenture made this twenty fourth of december in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and sixty Eight between William Johnson Senior of the one part and John Thorpe of the other part both of the county of Southampton Witnesseth that the said William Johnson Senior for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds Current money of him in hand well and truly paid by the said John Thorpe the receipt whereof he the said William Johnson doth hereby acknowledge he the said William Johnson hath and do grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said John Thorpe one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the said County of Southampton and on the south side of the tree Cretaks containing as is estimation forty acres be the same more or less and is bounded as follows to wit beginning at the mouth of the branch of Gums branch then up the said branch to the said John Thorpe line to the thence up the said line along the said Thorpe line to the pinery branch then down the pinery branch to Georges branch then up the said Georges branch to the beginning it being part of a tract of land granted to Henry Rose by letters patent and also all houses lands ways, waters water courses profits commodities advantages hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of land belongin or in any wise appurtenanting and also the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and remainder and remainders rents and services of all and singular the said premises and every part and parcel thereof and also all the estate right Title Interest property Claim and demand whatsoever of him the said William Johnson of in & to the same To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said John Thorpe his heirs and assigns forever and he the said William Johnson the said tract or parcel of land to the said John Thorpe his heirs and assigns against him the said William Johnson and his heirs and against all other persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever by these presents In witness whereof he the said William Johnson Senior hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above Written
