Chris one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy Eight Between Ephraim pobles
and Hannah pobles his wife of Brunswick County of ~~the one~~ part and
Colin Person of Southampton County of the other part witnesseth that the said
Ephraim Pobles and Hannah Pobles his wife for and in consideration of the
sum of five hundred pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid
by the said Colin Person at or before the Enscaling and delivery hereof
the receipt whereof the said Ephraim Pobles and both hereby acknow-
ledge and hereof doth acquit the said Colin Persons his heirs
and Executors and Administrators hath Bargained Sold Alien
Enfeoffed Confirmed and made over unto said Colin Person his heirs and
Assigns forever all that Tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being
in the County of Southampton on Meherrin River Beginning at a
hickory on Meherrin River a Corner of Persons line line thence
along the various Courses of said Persons Land to a corner hickory
formerly, but now a small Sycamore the upper corner the said Person
land then a marked line to the mouth of a small branch in the
old field then the dividing line between Richard Harrison and said
tract to a corner pine opposite to the upper end said path thence
along William an arms Dividing line of Mark trees to the head head of
of branch then down said branch to Franks branch thence up the said
Franks branch to Thomas Cliftons line thence along said Cliftons line
to a corner dogwood, thence along said Cliftons line to Meherrin River then
down the various Courses of said River to the beginning Containing by
