Nottingham in the County of Southampton Sendeth greeting whereas by one certain
indenture or deed of trust one thousand and seven hundred and seventy seven
duly acknowledged and received in the County of the County of Southampton
and made between the said Thomas Lane of the one part and Nathaniel
Felts of the same County of the other part whereby the said Nathaniel Felts sold
and conveyed unto the said Thomas Lane in fee simple one certain tract
or parcel of Land lying in the said County of Southampton on the south
side of Round hill swamp containing two hundred and ninety seven acres
purchased by him of one Jesse Johns. in trust and for the purpose of
and saving harmless the said Thomas Lane his heirs executors or administrators
for and by reason of his entering into and executing a certain writing ob-
ligation for the sum of eighty pounds to one Richard Wren as security for and
on behalf of the said Nat Felts and whereas the said Nathaniel Felts hath
performed the condition of the writing obligation aforesaid by the payment of the
principal sum and interest thereon and cancelled the said written whereby the
said Thomas Lane his heirs & assigns are now discharged from the obligation
of the same & thereby sufficiently indemnified and saved harmless now know-
ye therefore that I the said Thomas Lane as well in pursuance of the covenants
contained in the afore recited indenture relation being thereto had will more fully
