year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and Seven-
ty nine. Between John Drake of the County of Southampton
of the one part and Jonas Bryant of the County of aforesaid
of the other part witnesseth that the said John Drake for in
consideration of the sum of Sixty six pound current money to him
in hand paid by the said Jonas Bryant the receipt whereof he the said
John Drake doth hereby Acknowledge have and each of them hath
granted Bargained sold Alienated enfeoffed and Confirmed & by these
presents do and each of them doth grant bargain sell Alien enfeoff
and Confirmed unto the said Jonas Bryant and to his heirs and
Assigns forever all that Tract or parcel of Land and premises
with the Appurtenances situate lying and being in the County
of Southampton Containing by estimation Forty Acres be the
same more or less and bounded as followeth. Beginning at a white
Oak John Williamson line on Powells branch thence down the
said branch to the Spring Branch thence up the said branch
to a pine thence along a line of naked trees to a Maple in the Mire
branch thence up the said Branch to a pine thence along a line of
line to a white Oak a corner thence along a line of market Trees
to a red Oak in said Bryants old line which said Land will
more fully Appear in a patent granted to & thence Taylor
