To all Christian People to whome these presents shall come I Thomas Crenshaw of the County of Southampton send greeting know ye that I the said Thomas Crenshaw for a win consideration of the love Affection and goodwill which I have and do bear to and as my loving Daughter Ann Crenshaw, of the County aforesaid have given and granted and by these presents do freely Clearly and absolutely give and grant to the said Ann Crenshaw and to her heirs Executors &c. One Negro man Called and known by the name of Mingo To have and from henceforth as her proper Negro forever Absolutely without any manner of Condition as I the said Thomas Crenshaw have absolutely and of my own accord set and put in further Testament in witness whereof I the said Thomas Crenshaw have hereunto set my hand and Seal the sixteenth Day of October in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy eight

This Indenture made this thirteenth day of May Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and Seventy Nine between Albritton Jones of the County of Southampton of the one part and Joseph Washington of the aforesaid County of the other part with witnesseth that the said Albritton Jones for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds Current money to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Washington at or before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Albritton Jones doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened confirmed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain alien and confirm unto the said Joseph Washington his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by Estimation Eighty five Acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows viz Beginning at a pine on the north side of Notaway swamp a corner tree of Edward Goodson and Matthew Rushings former Land thence by the line north by we go fifty poles to a pine thence north seven seven degrees East thirty eight pole to a red Oak over a branch thence North sixty degrees one hundred and Seventy poles
