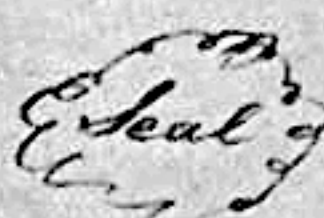

between William Kitchen and Martha his wife of the county of Southam-
ton and parish of Nottoway of the one part and ^{Christian} ~~Christian~~ Denson of
of the parish of Nottoway and County of Southampton aforesaid of the
other part witnesseth that the said William Kitchen and Mary his wife
for and in consideration of the just and full sum of thirty pounds
Current money of Virginia by the said Christian Denson to them in hand
paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents ^{the receipt} whereof the said
William Kitchen and Martha his wife doth hereby acknowledge
and thereof acquit and discharge the said Christian Denson her heirs
Executors administrators and assigns forever and themselves there-
with fully and intirely satisfied contented and paid hath granted
bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released set over delivered and by these
presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release set over deliver
and Confirm unto said Christian Denson and to her heirs and assigns
forever all that plantation meadow tract and parcel of Land sit-
uate lying and being in the parish of Nottoway and county of Southam-
ton aforesaid being part of a patent granted to Lewis Bryant and
by the said Bryant sold to Robert Tyler and by the said Tyler con-
veyed to Richard Worrel who sold the same to James Kitchen who
dying did by his last will and testament devised the same to his
son Joseph Kitchen who sold and conveyed the same with other Lands
to the aforesaid William Kitchen by indenture recorded in the County
court of Southampton in the year of our Lord 1778 containing
by estimation one hundred acres more or less and bounded as follows
to wit beginning at a pine in Benjamin Barnes line thence
along the line formerly John Barnes line to a pine corner
tree in John Blythes line formerly William Harris thence the said Blythes
