This Indenture this fourteenth day of October the year of our Lord
Christ one thousand Seven hundred Seventy and nine between Jesse
Williams of the county of Halifax in the state of North Carolina
and Isaac Williams of the parish of Nottoway and County of Southampton
in the state of Virginia administrators with the annex of James Moore late
of the ~~county~~ said parish of Nottoway and County of Southampton dead
of the one part and Elizabeth Moore of the parish of Nottoway and County
of Southampton aforesaid of the other part whereas the aforesaid James Moore
was in his life time and at the time of his death seized in fee simple &
in one certain plantation meadow tract and parcel of land whereon
Benjamin Hale now lives and known by the name of Ingrams place situate
lying and being in the parish of Nottoway and County of Southampton
aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred eighty and three acres be
the same same more or less and being part of the lands which the aforesaid
James Moore bought of Arthur Joyner and comprised in two separate deeds
bounded and described as by the said Arthur Joyner's deeds for the same to the
aforesaid James Moore is expressed and mentioned except on side thereof which
is bounded by John Bradley's line And whereas the aforesaid James Moore
did by his last will and testament in writing devise will and direct the
aforesaid lands and premises to be sold in pursuance whereof and under
a decree of the county court of Southampton bearing date eleventh day of March
1773 the aforesaid Jesse Williams and Isaac Williams did expose the aforesaid
land to public sale whereof the aforesaid Elizabeth Moore became the purchaser
ever now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the
just and full sum of two thousand pounds current Money of Virginia by
the said Elizabeth Moore to the said Jesse Williams and Isaac Williams
in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
the said Jesse Williams and Isaac Williams do hereby acknowledge and thereof
acquit and discharge the said Elizabeth Moore her heirs executors administrators
and assigns forever and themselves therewith fully and intirely satisfied con-
tented and paid they the said Jesse Williams and Isaac Williams have granted
bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released set over delivered and confirmed and by these
presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff released set over deliver and confirm
unto the said Elizabeth Moore and to her heirs and assigns forever all that plan-
tation meadow tract and parcel of land and premises as aforesaid and
all the houses out houses edifices buildings woods ways waters and water
courses profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever
