 John Speed for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and ten pounds
 current money of Virginia the receipt whereof the said John Speed doth here by
 acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge the said William Edwards his heirs Executors
 and administrators forever hath granted bargained and ^{Sell} doth by these presents
 grant bargain and Sell unto the said William Edwards one certain tract or
 parcel of Land lying and being in the parish of Nottoway and county of South-
 ampton containing by estimation ^{one} hundred & eighty acres be the same more or less
 being part part of a tract of ^{two} hundred acres sold by Albrigthton Jones to
 William Speed as will appear by Indenture of bargain and Sale bearing
 date the thirtieth of March one thousand seven hundred & sixty two recorded
 in Southampton County which said Land was given by will by the said Wil-
 liam Speed to his son John Speed party to these presents the other twenty
