This Indenture made this 10th day of June in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy nine between Jonas Bryant and Elizabeth his wife of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Jonas Bryant of the county aforesaid witnesseth that the said Jonas Bryant and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of forty pounds to him in hand paid by the said Jonas Bryant the Receipt whereof the said Jonas Bryant and Elizabeth his wife hath acknowledged themselves fully satisfied for fifteen Acres of land more or less Situate lying and being in the county of Southampton and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a small black gum in the long branch thence along John Everitto line to a pine in Lewis Bryants line thence along Lewis line to a lightwood pump in Simon Vicks line and thence along said Vicks line to white oak thence along the branch to the beginning To have and hold all and singular the above bargained premises to him the said Jonas Bryant his heirs and assigns forever to proper use and behoof of them and every of them and the said Jonas Bryant and Elizabeth his wife at the time of Sealing and delivery of these presents am lawfully Seised of the above land with the appurtenances thereunto belonging in fee simple and the said Jonas Bryant and Elizabeth my wife do for ourselves our heirs assigns forever warrant and defend the said land and premises against all and all manner of persons laying any Just Right or claim thereto and that the said land is free and Cleare of all Incumbrances whatsoever in witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our Seals the day and Year first above written
