Turner This Indenture made this 25th day of March in the year of our lord Christ one thousand Seven hundred & Seventy Nine between Joseph Turner of Southampton County Virginia of the one part and Thomas Turner of the said County of the other part witnesseth that the said Joseph Turner for & in consideration of the sum of Eighty hundred pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Turner the receipt whereof the said Joseph Turner doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold aliened and confirm unto the said Thomas Turner his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land containing three hundred and twenty acres be the same more or less lying and being in the county of Southampton the south side of Northampton River and bounded as followeth to wit beginning at a pine at the head of the Wolfpond branch thence East by North eighty poles to a red oak in Richleys line thence by the said Richleys line S^o Sixty degrees east 72 poles to a red oak N 67^o Degrees E 86 poles to live oak by the side of Richard branch thence up the said S^o 0 Degrees West 50 pole to a white oak thence S^o 0 degrees W 102 poles to a red oak thence N 25 degrees W 131 poles to two maples in the Wolfpond branch aforesaid thence up the various courses of the run of the said branch to the beginning
