

This Indenture made this twentieth day of August and in  
 the fourth year of the common wealth and in the year of our Lord Christ  
 one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy nine between Joseph Vaffer  
 and Tabitha his wife of the parish of Nottoway and county of Southampton  
 of the one part and John Gardner of the parish and county aforesaid  
 witnesseth that the said Joseph Vaffer Junr & Tabitha his wife for  
 and in consideration of sum of three hundred pounds current  
 money to him in hand paid by the said John Gardner his heirs executors  
 and administrators by these presents they the said Joseph Vaffer Junr and  
 Tabitha his wife have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed & by these  
 presents do grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said John  
 Gardner & to his heirs and assigns forever that part of that plantation  
 tract or parcel of land that fell to him by his Brother Elijah Vaffer deceased  
 Situate and lying and being in the parish of Nottoway and county aforesaid  
 and on both sides of black Creek swam by estimation one hundred and thirty  
 five acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a  
 pine sapling in Joseph Vaffers line thence running east down Saines line to a  
 light wood post thence South to a white oak in black creek swamp thence  
 South to James Chappells line to a pine f Sapling thence west along the said  
 Chappells line to a oak post a corner of Samuel Sandeford line from <sup>North</sup>  
 to a white oak Sapling in black creek thence up the main run of black  
 Creek to a pine thence North to a walnut tree in the plantation thence  
 North to the begining and houses out houses Edifices building garas gardens  
 orchards trees ways waters water courses profits commodities hereditam  
 and appurtenances whatsoever to the said plantation tract or parcel of land  
 belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions  
 remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and every part  
 thereof and all the estate right title interest possession property claim  
 and demand whatsoever of them the said Joseph Vaffer Junr and Tabitha  
 his wife of in or to the same To have and to hold the said plantation  
 tract or parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said  
 John Gardner his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of  
 him the said John Gardner his heirs and assigns forever and the said  
 Joseph Vaffer Junr and his heirs & assigns & the said premises with the  
 appurtenances unto the said John Gardner his heirs and assigns  
 against all and every person and persons whatsoever lawfully claiming  
 or to claiming or to claim by form or under him them or any of them  
 Shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents in witness  
 whereof the said Joseph Vaffer Junr and Tabitha his wife have hereunto  
 set their hands and affixed their Seals the day & year first above written
