This indenture made this 27th day of August in the year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred and seventy nine between Jacob Williams of the
County of Southampton and parish of Rottonway of the one part and William
Urquhart of the same parish and county of the other part witnesses
that the said Jacob Williams for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid on before the sealing
or delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Jacob Williams doth
heavily acknowledge and hereof acquit and discharge the said William
Urquhart his heirs and assigns forever hath granted bargain and sold and
by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said William Urquhart his
heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being
in the County in the County of Southampton and parish of Rottonway and
on the South Side of Seacock Swamp containing two hundred & twenty
Acres more or less & known by the most known & reported bounds it being
the plantation whereon the said Jacob Williams now lives & which land he
bought of Williams Land who had the same from Richard Killo of the
same County as will at large appear by the Records of the County Court of
Southampton and all houses out house orchards gardens woods water courses and
all appurtenances belonging or in any wise appurtenant to the said tract or parcel
of Land ~~and have~~ ^{Tract of} to hold the said Land and premises unto the said William
Urquhart his heirs and assigns forever and the said Jacob Williams for
himself his heirs and executors doth covenant to and with the said William
Urquhart his heirs executors administrators and assigns by these presents
that the said Jacob Williams and his heirs the said premises with the appurtenances
unto the said Jacob Williams William Urquhart his heirs executors & assigns against
Claim of all and every person or persons claiming right therein shall and
will warrant and forever defend by these presents in witness whereof
the said Jacob Williams hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the
day and year first above written
