This Indenture made this sixteenth day of december one thousand seven hundred and Seventy nine between William Denson of the parish of Sottoway and county of Southampton of the one part and Henry Pope of the same parish and of the other part witnesseth that the said William Denson for and in consideration of the sum of eighty pounds Current money of virginia to him in hand paid by the said Henry Pope the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain sold alien released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien Release and confirm unto the said Henry Pope and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land and premises with appurtenances unto the said Henry Pope situate lying and being in the aforesaid parish of Sottoway and county Southampton containing thirty acres or the same more or less and bounded as followeth (to wit) beginning at a pine standing in the aforesaid densons line and from a line of markt trees to a scrub oak by the said Densons old field, at Cornice tree and then a line of Markt trees to a pine that divides this from the land of david denson and by the said David Denson line to Prudons Clarkes line so up the said line to a pine the first station the same is part of a tract of land granted to Francis Denson a patten bargain date the fifteenth day of December one thousand seven hundred and forty nine and from the said Francis Denson to him son William Denson by will with all houses out houses edifices building Yards Gardens ways water and water Courses profits Commodities hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said tract or parcel of land belonging or in any wise appurtenant and the reversions and Reversions Remainders Rents issues and profits thereof and all the estate right title interest use trust possession property claim and demand Same and demand whatsoever of him the of the said William Denson of in and to the same and every part and thereof and all deeds
