 parish of the one part Franklin Clark of the aforesaid county of the other
 part Witnesses that the said Joseph Vassor Junr & Tabitha his wife
 for and in consideration of the sum of Seventeen hundred and fifty pounds
 current Money of Virginia Current to the said Joseph Vassor
 Tabitha Vassor his wife in hand paid by the said Franklin Clark
 at or before the enscaling and Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
 the said Joseph Vassor Junr and Tabitha his wife doth acknowledge
 and thereof acquit and discharge the said Franklin Clark hath
 bargained and Sold aliened inoff and confirmed and by these doth grant
 bargain and Sell alien enfeof and confirm unto the said Franklin
 Clark to him and his heirs forever all that tract or parcel of land
