

Know all Men by these presents that I Arthur Smith of the County of Southampton for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings lawful Money of Virginia to me in hand paid by Matthew Smith of foresaid County the Receipt whereof I do hereby Acknowledge have Bargained Sold & Delivered & by these presents do Bargain Sell and Deliver unto the said Matthew Smith one Mare and Colt four of Chattle Six Sheep six hogs three Beds and furniture three Iron Pots one frying pan all my pewter two plowing hoes four weeding hoe three chests three Tables with Carpenter and Coopers Tools one whip Saw one hand Mill Cart & wheels. Spice Mortar box Iron & heaters. Iron Wedges Gubbing hoe, and all the Remainder of my property that I possess to have and to hold the said bargained premises unto the said Matthew Smith his Executors administrators & Assigns forever and I the said Arthur Smith for myself my heirs Executors and administrators shall and will warrant & forever defend against all persons by these presents the said bargained premises unto the said Matthew Smith his heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns forever in witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this third Day of May 1780

This Indenture made this 20th day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & Seventy Nine Between William Wooten of the County of Edgecomb in the in the state of North Carolina of the one part & John Pope of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Wooten for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Pope the receipt whereof the said William Wooten doth hereby Acknowledge he the said William Wooten hath granted bargained and sold alien and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien & confirm unto the said John Pope his heirs and Assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia Being on the South side of the main Black Water Swamp containing by Estimation one hundred & ten acres more or less the said land being part of a patent Granted to Edward Goodson & Matthew Rusher bearing date the sixteenth day of June one thousand Seven hundred and a fourteen and bounded as follows (to wit) beginning at a Hickory a corner tree of James Bullocks corner in Goodsons pattern line then along the said line to a Spanish Oak then North twenty four degrees West fifty pole to a red oak then North Seventy six
