 Nine between Jesse & Isaac Williams administrators with the will
 annexed of James Moore deced of the County of Southampton of the
 one part and Thomas Peter of the County of Sussex Gentleman of the other
 Whereas one Thomas Gray the elder late of the County of Southampton
 was in his lifetime seized and possessed of one certain tract or parcel of
 land containing by estimation nine hundred & Sixty Acres lying & being in
 the parish of Nottoway in the said County of Southampton in Nottoway
 Swamp which at the time of his death descended to Thomas Gray his eldest
 son and heir at law who by one certain indenture bearing date
