 provided always & it is the true intent and Meanin of these presents
 that if the said Joseph Gurley his heirs Executors or administrators
 shall and do well truly pay unto the above said Jesse Drew his
 Executors administrators or assigns the full Sum of Seven Thousand
 pounds Currant money of Virginia with the Expence of preparing
 drawing and Recording these presents on or before the twenty fifth
 day of April Next ensuing without any deduction or abatement
 whatsoever then these presents to be void and of no effect or else
 to be and remain in full force and virtue but if default should
 be made in payment of the said principal money and the aforesaid
 Expences Contrary to the provision above mentioned that then it
 shall and may be lawfull to and for the said Jesse Drew his Executors
 and Assigns at any time after the above Mentioned date to Sell
 and dispose of the above mentioned negro woman Called Amy as
 the said Jesse Drew his executors administrators of assigns shall
 think fit at Such price or prices as may reasonable be had or obtain
 for the same and share out on the first place to pay deduct or retain
 to him or themselves all such Money as Shall become due and
 be unpaid with the aforesaid Charges of these present and the over
 plus of Such money if any be Delivered unto the said Joseph
 his heirs or assign in witness whereof I have hereto set my hand
 and Seal this first day of February Seventeen hundred and Eighty one
