 of the other part witnesseth that the said Benjamin Deloach & Ann his wife for and in consideration of the sum of four thousand pound current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Beverly Booth at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof the said Benjamin Deloach doth hereby acknowledge thereof acquit and discharge the said Beverly Booth his heirs and assigns by these presents have & each of them hath granted Bargained Sold aliened released enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain sell alien release enfeoff and confirm unto the said Beverly Booth and to his heirs and assigns all that plantation tract or parcel of land Situate lying and being in the afore said parish of Nottoway afore county of Southampton containing by estimation three hundred and thirty five acres be the same more or less bounded according to the most known ancient and reputed bounds which said land were purchased by the above Benjamin Deloach of Anthony Calthorp by Indenture bearing date the Ninth of March one thousand seven hundred & Eighty and all houses out houses edifices buildings yards orchards trees wood ways waters water Courses profits commodities hereditaments and & appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or in any wise appurtenances and the reversions and Reversions remainders and remainders rents Issues and profits thereof and all the estate right title Interest and trust Possession property claim & demand whatsoever of them the said Benjamin Deloach & Ann his wife of in & to the same & every part & parcel thereof & all evidences & writings & touching or in any wise concerning the same To have and to hold the said plantation tract or parcel of land & premises with the appurtenances unto the said Beverly Booth his heirs & assigns
