 in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds current money  
 of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Nicholas Boon a receipt

 and sold alien and confirm unto the said Nicholas Boon his heirs  
 and assigns forever one hundred and eighty acres of land lying  
 and being in Southampton County in Virginia bounded as followeth
