This Indenture made this the fifteenth day of February one thousand Seven hundred and Eighty one Between Isaac Williams & Priscilla his wife of the county of Southampton & parish of Nottoway of the one part. and Lewis Joyner Senr of the County and parish aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Isaac Williams and Priscilla his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three thousand pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid before the enrolling and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Isaac Williams and Priscilla his wife doth hereby Acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Lewis Joyner Senr his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever by these presents and themselves therewith fully contented satisfied and paid. they the Isaac Williams and Priscilla his wife hath granted Bargained Sold Aligned Enfeoffed releasd sotover and confirm unto the said Lewis Joyner & to his heirs and assigns and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of Southampton aforesaid and on the North side of Cabin Swamp Containing by estimation fifty Acres of Land be the same more or less. It being part of a tract of Land by Jordan Denson and the said Isaac Williams bought of Thomas Mills bearing date the tenth of September 1772 fifty Acres is bounded as follows (to wit) beginning at a gum
