on the south side of the said Creek a joining the said three acres and including the said Mill
and all the appurtenances thereto belonging to have and to hold the said Mill and all the
appurtenances thereto belonging in any wife appertaining and the reversion and reversions
remainder and remainders with issue profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof and
all the Estate right title Interest profit claim and demand whatsoever of them the said Henry
Taylor and Susanna his wife of in and to the same and every part thereof and all Deeds ordinals
and writings touching or in any wise concerning the same To have and to hold the said
tract or parcel of Land and Mill with the appurtenances unto the said Matthew Williamson
and to his Heirs and Assigns to the only proper use & behoof of the said Williamson his Heirs and
Assigns forever, and the said Henry Taylor for himself his Heirs Executors and Administrators doth
covenant promise and grant to and with the said Matthew Williamson his Heirs and Assigns forever
by these presents that he the said Taylor and his Heirs. The said tract or parcel of Land and Mill
with the appurtenances unto the said Williamson his Heirs and Assigns against all & every person
or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same for any part or parcel thereof shall
and will warrant aid fence defend by these presents In witness whereof the Henry Taylor and his
wife Susannah have to these presents set their hands and affixed their seals the day and Year
