This Indenture made this twelfth day of April one thousand seven hundred and eighty one Between Nicholas Maget Exor. of Thomas Turner deceased of the one part and Benjamin Blunt of the County Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Blunt of the County Southampton bearing date the fourteenth of September one thousand seven hundred and eighty hath for the consideration of Twenty Five Thousand pounds w^t of West Virginia inspected Tobacco sold unto the said Blunt all that Plantation and tract or parcel of land (situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and on the north side of Tarroriahoo Creek) Whereon Thomas Turner deceased formerly lived containing by estimation eight hundred and thirty five acres More or less and bounded according to the known antient and reputed bounds thereof together with all Houses Woods Ways waters Privileges Profits Commodities Hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land and Premises are belonging or in any wise appertaining together with the rents Profits and issues and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said Land and Premises to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Benjamin Blunt his heirs and assigns forever and the said Nicholas Maget doth covenant and agree with the said Blunt that he the said Benjamin Blunt his heirs and assigns shall and may at all times forever hereafter peaceably and quietly have hold use occupy and enjoy the said Land and Premises with their and every of their appurtenances free from all Claims or demands that shall or may be made by the heirs of the said Thomas Turner deceased or any person or persons claiming under or by them and from no other person
