

This Indenture made this second day January One thousand seven hundred and Eighty two Between Mary Jackson of Southampton County in Virginia and Nicholas Boon in the State of North Carolina and County of Guilford of the other part Witnesseth that the said Mary Jackson for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds in Gold or Silver to her in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivering hereof the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell all her right title claim and demand of in and to one hundred Acres of Land fifty acres being the claim of the said Mary Jackson with the appurtenances lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton be the same more or less it being part of the land Henr^y By the v^{ty} Mary Jackson on the death of her Father George Jackson Esq^r joined together with all Houses and buildings thereon with the appurtenances to have and to hold the said Rights as aforesaid unto her the said Nicholas Boon his Heirs Executors Administrators or assigns I the said Mary Jackson with for myself my heirs and assigns warrant and forever defend the aforesaid Bargained premises unto the aforesaid Nicholas Boon or his Heirs and assigns against the claims and demands of All persons or persons whatsoever for ever more unincumbered In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day and Year above Written
