With all Houses buildings Woods Ways Water courses Proffits Commodities of Hereditaments whatsoever to the said Land belonging (In anywise thereto appertaining) the Remainder of the same Remains and Remains Parts of the said Tract and all the Right Title of Interest of the said Jesse Arrington & Martha his Wife of in and to the same. To have the whole all & singular the said Tract and Parcel with the appurtenances unto the s^d William Ellis his heirs and Assigns forever. And the s^d Jesse Arrington and Martha his wife for themselves & their Heirs this Land and every part thereof against them and their Heirs & Assigns against all and every the Person or Persons whatsoever shall if will warrant & forever defend unto the s^d William Ellis his Heir and Assigns forever.
