

This Indenture made the Eleventh day of July one thousand seven hundred and eighty two Between Britton Jeynes and Tabitha his Wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and John Drake of the County of Dorset of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the just sum of One hundred pounds Virginia Currency by the said John Drake in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivering of this indenture the Receipt whereof the v.^o Britton Jeynes & Tabitha his wife doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and for ever discharge the v.^o John Drake his heirs & assigns forever and by these presents the v.^o Britton Jeynes and Tabitha his wife hath granted bargained & sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell alien, release and confirm unto the v.^o John Drake his heirs & assigns forever all that Plantation tract or parcel of land, whereon the said Britton Jeynes now lives, being the same land that the v.^o Jeynes purchased of Sir William situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Netton containing by estimation One hundred acres more less and bounded as followeth, to wit beginning at the main road at a place called John Drayes field at a white Oak, thence along a line of marked trees, to a white Oak thence to a red oak thence to another red oak thence to a red oak thence to a Tansley oak thence to sweet gum in the branch, or corner tree of the v.^o branch the various course, to Hardy Thomas line that formerly was thence v.^o line to Barnaby Krahers line thence v.^o line to Dracy Johns now Scotty to William Scotts line thence v.^o line to the first station, being part of tract of land granted to Richard Drake by Alexander Spotswood Esq. by patent bearing date the thirteenth day November one thousand seven hundred & thirteen & by the v.^o convey to George Williams by Indenture bearing date the ninth day of August 1784 & by the v.^o George Williams's convey to the above mentioned Sir William by Indenture bearing date the day of with all houses out houses edifices buildings woods ~~and~~ waists water & water courses profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging
