This Indenture, made the twentieth day of May in the Year One thousand seven hundred and eighty two. Between John Hinder of South Hampton County of the said part and Thomas Holiday of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Hinder for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty six pounds (Virginia Currency) to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Holiday, the Receipt whereof the said John Hinder doth hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and confirm unto the said Thomas Holiday his Heirs and assigns Two tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the County aforesaid numbered one is bounded as follows: Beginning at a white oak standing on a branch thence along a line of marked trees to a Pond at the road side thence along a line of marked trees to a corner of Joseph Diller, thence along a line of marked trees to the half hatched branch thence down said branch to a white oak a corner tree of Elizabeth Sumlyers Land thence along a line of marked trees to a Hickory another corner tree of Ely Sumlyers, thence along a line of marked trees to the beginning, being the Plantation whereon Thomas Sumly formerly did live containing by estimation two hundred and forty five Acres (be the same more or less) Number two beginning at a white oak on the South side of Fishing hole branch, thence South fourteen degrees West sixty pole to a black oak then west by north the sixty eight pole to a white oak by a small branch side then down the run of the branch to Kingstons branch aforesaid then up the various courses of said branch to the beginning. Being the Plantation whereon Joseph Sumly formerly did live containing eighty four Acres (more or less) Together with all Houses, Orchards, Woods, Ways, water Waterscourses, privileges, profits, Commodities, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances thereunto belonging to both Tracts or parcels of land and premises in any wise appertaining with the reversion and reversions remainders and remainders and every part and parcel thereof
