

This Indenture made this Eleventh Day of December, one
 Thousand seven Hundred and Eighty Three Between Micaiah Pope
 and Tiller his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and
 Benjamin Blount of the County aforesaid of the other Part Witness
 - yeeth that for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty
 five pounds Current of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said
 Blount on or before the signing and sealing these Presents the
 Receipt Whereof They the said Micaiah Pope and Tiller his
 Wife, doth acknowledge and hath granted Bargained and
 sold and by these presents doth Grant Bargain and sell
 unto the said Benjamin Blount his heirs and assigns
 forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being
 in the County of Southampton and Parish of St. Lukes and
 is bounded as followeth to wit; Beginning at a pine in the
 Reddy branch, Thence north forty six Degrees west, twenty
 five pole, to a shrub white Oak, Then north sixty nine degrees
 west forty pole to a pine then west Thirty four Pole to a
 Hickory, then south Eighty Degrees west twenty eight pole to
 a spanish Oak, then west forty one Pole to a pine thence
 North three Degrees west, one hundred & Eighteen pole to
 an old Turkey Oak, thence north fifty seven Degrees east one
 Hundred and Twelve pole to a pine then south sixty seven
 East sixty eight pole to a pine, Then south Thirty three
 Degrees west twenty six pole to shrub oak in the head of a
 small Branch, Thence down the said Branch to the red dy beam
 - th, then down the red dy Branch to the Beginning, the above
 mentioned Bounds Including one Hundred and fifty acres
 of Land together with more or less Together with all House
 Orchards woodways waters and Water Courses Privileges
 Hereditaments appurtenances Thereunto belonging or in
 any wise appurtenant To have and to hold the
 said Land and Premises to the only proper use and behoof
