This Indenture made this sixteenth Day of September in
the year of our Lord Christ One Thousand seven hundred eighty
two Between Matthew Johnson of the County of Southampton
and Parish of Nettoway of the one part and Isaac Williams of
The County aforesaid of the Other Part Whereas the said Isaac
Williams did at the Request of the said Matthew Johnson become
Bound with him unto Jordan Denson as Executor of James Jordan
Scott deceased unto Jordan Denson each a Part The whole amounting
unto the sum of Fifty five Pounds Eighteen Shillings and Ten pence Current
Money of Virginia & The Costs of two attachments Which the said
Jordan Denson obtained against & levied on the estate of the said Matthew
Johnson and also he the said Isaac Williams and James Jordan Scott
decd. did likewise at the Request of The said Matthew Johnson become
Bound with the said Matthew Johnson unto the County Court of Southam-
pton For the said Matthew Johnsons True and Faithfull administering
The estate of Anne Johnson Decd. & for the other Purposes in the Condition
of The said Bond Specified: and it is but Reasonable That the said Isaac Williams
and Estate of James Jordan Scott deceased should be secured from all Damage
That may arise From Their becoming The said Matthew Johnsons
Security aforesaid Now this indenture witnesseth
That for securing & saving harmless the said Isaac Williams and the
Estate of James Jordan Scott decd. From all Damage That may hereafter
arise
