his Wife of Southampton County of the one part and Jacob
Harris of same County of the other part Witnesseth that
that the said Jesse Brill & his wife Elizabeth Brill for and
in consideration of the sum of Three hundred pounds Current money
of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Jacob Harris the
receipt whereof the said Jesse Brill and Elizabeth his wife
doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold
aliened and confirmed and by these presents do grant
bargain sell alien and Confirm unto the said Jacob Harris
his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel
of Land containing two hundred and seventy acres be the
same
