I Mary Ricks, of Southampton County Virginia having
Under my care one Negro Woman named Judy, aged Twentyseven
years and six months which I have heretofore held as slave, but
Being fully persuaded that Freedom is the Natural right of
all mankind, and that it is my Duty to do by others as I would
they should do by me, Do therefore hereby emancipate and
set the said Judy free and do for myself my heirs executors
and administrators relinquish all my Right till Interest
and Claim or pretensions of claim whatsoever either to her
person or to any estate she may hereafter acquire, and having
also five now in their minority vizt Venus a negro girl about ten
years of age, David aged eight years the 25th of the twelve month
March last being nearly six years of age the 12th of April last
past, I am three years sometime in the twelve month next
Anney one year the 27th of the third month next, whom I
likewise emancipate and set free yet I believe it right
for me to have the care of them until they shall attain the
Males to Twenty one years, & the females to eighteen
years, and I do for myself my heirs, executors and administrators
relinquish all my right till Interest and Claim or preten-
sions of claim whatsoever either to their persons or to any
estate they may acquire after they shall to the full and
lawfull age aforesaid all the above named Negroes to enjoy their
full
