This Indenture Made this twenty fourth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty two Between, William Moore of Southampton County on the one part & Thomas Pate of Deepsea County on the other part Witnesseth that the said William Moore hath for & in consideration of the sum of one thousand fifty pounds specie to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Pate the receipt whereof the said William Moore, both hereby Acknowledge and Confess, hath given, granted, Bargained, sold and by these presents both gives, grant, Bargain sell, alien, enfeoff & confirm, unto the said Thomas Pate his heirs or assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by two patents granted to Thomas Moore, Father to the said William Moore party to these presents. One patent bearing date July the twenty sixth, one thousand seven hundred and eighty five for seven hundred & fifteen Acres, and the other patent bearing date July the fourteenth one thousand seven hundred & ninety three for one hundred and thirty Acres, Making in the whole Eight hundred & forty five Acres, bounded by the most famous and Ancient bounds, Reference to the said needed patents will fully appear. All thing the land and plantation the above said Thomas Moore devised to his son Thomas by his last will & Testament and the said Thomas last dying in his nonage & without issue it descended by right of inheritance to the said William Moore eldest son & heir of the said Thomas Moore deceased. The said Tracts or parcel of Land lying being in the County of Southampton on the north side of the River creek adjoining the said creek, also all woods under wood ways water & Water courses, profits commodities Advantages, emoluments and hereditaments whatsoever to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto in or upon the same growing happening or arising & also the reversion, and Reversions, Remainder and Remainders Parts and Shares of all & singular the said premises & Every part & parcel thereof with the appertinances thereto belonging To have and to hold forever unto the said Pate his heirs and assigns all & singular the said premises and every part thereof & the
