This Indenture Made this eighteenth Day of April
in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and
Eighty three Between Barefoot Dorch of North Carolina
Dobbs County of the one part, and George Juy of the state
of Virginia County of Southampton of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Barefoot Dorch for and
in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds Current
Money of Virginia in hand paid by the said George Juy
the Receipt whereof the said Barefoot Dorch doth hereby
acknowledge hath Granted Bargained sold aliened
enjoyed and Confirmed and by these Presents do grant
Bargain sell aliened and Confeison unto the said George
Juy his Heirs and assigns Forever, one certain tract or
Parcel of Land containing seventy five acres be the same
more or less, lying and being in Southampton in
Virginia on the north side of Meherrin River, and
Bounded as followeth (to wit) **B**eginning at a pine by
the side of the Gum swamp, a corner of said George
Juy's land, but formerly Belonged to Henry Juy
thence by said Juy's line West 42 poles to a red oak
North 50 degrees West 90 poles to a red oak, north 10
degrees West 11 poles to a white oak, in the line of Henry
Addams formerly, thence South 87 degrees West
18 pole to a red oak in said Addams's line formerly
thence by said Addams's line South 10 degrees East 5th
Pole to a pine South 5 degrees West 43 pole to a small
Black oak, South 40 degrees West 3 1/2 pole to a white oak
a corner of James Lundy's land, thence along a dividing
line Between said Land and James Lundy's land to a
corner Black Oak in Joseph Harrison's line, formerly
Samuel Harrison's line; thence along the various
Courses
