the said Jeremiah Ellis doth hereby acknowledge hath
granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien
enfeoff and confirm unto the said James Atkinson his
Heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel
of land containing by estimation two hundred acres
more or less lying and being on the south side of
Muttonway being part of an including patent bearing
date the 14th day of and bounded as followeth
(to wit) Beginning at a small white oak thence
along Vicks line to an old line of Jeremiah Ellis
thence along the said line to a white oak a corner, then along
the said line to a pine, and thence to a red oak a corner of Newmans
land then along a line of new marked trees to a white oak a
corner, thence along a line of new marked trees to a pine,
Thence along a line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree
Thence
