This Indenture made this 18th day of January
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty
Between Hardy Harris of Southampton County in
State of Virginia of the one part and Moses Johnson of this
County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the
said Hardy Harris for and in consideration of the sum
of seven hundred pounds current money of Virginia to
him in hand paid by the said Moses Johnson the
Receipt whereof the said Hardy Harris both hereby
acknowledge and thereof him doth acquit, hath bargained
sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth
grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said
Moses Johnson his heirs Executors administrators &
 assigns, one certain tract or parcel of land situate &
 being in Southampton County and on the north side of
 Meherrin River containing by Patent one hundred
 and ninety five acres and bounded as followeth to wit
 Beginning at a pine a corner of Benjamin Harris
 Land thence North 72 degrees West one hundred and
 four poles to a pine thence N. E. 70 poles to a pine
 thence south 30 W. 78 poles to a pine thence S. E. 65
 E. 62 poles to a red oak thence S. 30. E. 108 poles three
 Trees Chopped inward thence S. 70 E. 12 poles to a black oak
 in Alexander Nations line, thence by his line N. 55
 E. 166 to a Hickory thence N. W. 8 ft. to a black oak a
 corner of Benjamin Harris Land aforesaid thence
 by the said Harris line N. 30 E. 90 poles to the
 Beginning with all woods under woods swamps marshes
 Meadows Feedings, and his due share of mines
 and all other appurtenances whatsoever to the said land
 belonging or appertaining thereto and also the Reversion
