This Indenture made this 11th day of April in
the year of our lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and
eighty three Between Benjamin Tucker John Tucker &
Henry Crofford Tucker of the County Southampton and state
Virginia of the one part and John Wilkinson of the County &
state aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the
said Benjamin Tucker, John Tucker and Henry Crofford
Tucker for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred
pounds virginia currency to the said Benjamin Tucker,
John & Henry Crofford Tucker in hand paid by the said
John Wilkinson at or before the sealing & delivery of
these presents the receipt Whereof the said Benjamin
Tucker, John & Henry Crofford Tucker doth hereby
acknowledge; Have and each of them Both granted
Bargained sold alien enfeoffed and confirm unto the said
John Wilkinson and to his heirs & assigns forever all
that Tract or parcel of land and premises with the
appurtenances situate lying and being in the County
Southampton and on the south side of Tarrors creek
Containing by Estimation Four hundred and
eighty
