This Indenture made this eleventh day of September Anno
Domini in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and
Eighty three Between Jacob Barnes and Milly his wife of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and
William Johnson and Obedience his wife of the county and state
of the other part Witnesseth that the said Jacob
Barnes and Milly his wife for and in consideration of the
Just and full sum of Fifty five pounds current money to them
in hand paid by the said William Johnson at and before the
sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the
said Jacob Barnes and Milly his wife doth hereby acknowl-
edge and themselves therewith fully satisfied Content and
Paid have Bargained sold aliened Enjoined and confirmed, and
by these presents doth bargain sell aliened Enjoined & forever
confirm unto the said William Johnson and Obedience his
Wife one certain tract or parcel of Land Lying on the southerly
side of the flaggy run swamp in the County of Sussex and
Parish of Kitterow containing by estimation Two hundred
acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth to wit
Beginning on the Line that parts the survey and the
Survey of John Barnes at the broad swamp so along said
Line to flaggy run swamp then up the run of the said swamp
to William Scotts land, then along Scotts line to the
broad swamp, then down the said broad swamp to the
Beginning being part of a patent granted to Barnaby
Machinné by the Honourable Alexander Spotswood
Lieutenant Governor of this Colony for four hundred
and ninety acres of land bearing Date the 25th of April
1714. And by the said Barnaby Machinné conveyed to Thomas
English by Deeds bearing Date the 8th & 10th day of July 1715
and by the said Thomas English devised to his son
