George Briggs hath given and granted and by these presents doth
give and grant alien and confirm unto him the said George
Briggs his heirs or assigns forever six Negroes namely Dany
Abba, Billy, Little Sarah, Letitia and Jimmy Hill which
said slaves I do freely give to him and his heirs forever to their
only proper use and behoof absolutely without any other manner
of condition given under my hand and seal the 11th day of
March 1784
