This Indenture made this 13th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty four Between John Haisty of the parish of Nottoway and County of Southampton of the one part & Elizabeth Drewry of the parish and County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Haisty for & in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds Current Money of Virginia to be paid by the said Elizabeth Drewry at or before the sealing & Relieving of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Haisty hath hereby fully acquit & Discharge the said Elizabeth Drewry & himself therein to be fully satisfied Contented & have granted bargained sold & Aloned enfeoffed & confirmed to the said Elizabeth Drewry her heirs Assigns forever, one parcel of land containing by estimation One hundred & fifty two Acres more or less and bounded as Followeth to wit, Beginning at the line tree between Elizabeth
Drewry
