 thereto Belonging or in any wise appertaining Together
 with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise
 appertaining to her the said Elizabeth Drewry her heirs
 & assigns forever and the said John Christy doth hereby
 agree with her the said Elizabeth Drewry that at the selling
 of these presents he had a perfect simple right & full title to
 dispose of the same free simple and discharge from all claims
 that shall be claimed by him and his heirs or any other
 Person or persons Whatsoever from this day forth forever
 according to the true Intent and meaning of these presents
 and the said John Christy the aforesaid one hundred &
 fifty two Acres of Land more or less with all its appurtenances
 from the claim the said John Christy his heirs Executors
