This Indenture made this tenth day of June in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty
Seven Between Hardy Harris and Ann his wife of the County
of Edgecomb County North Carolina of the one part and
Arthur Applewhite of Southampton County Virginia of the other
part Witnesseth that the said Hardy Harris and Ann
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three
Hundred pounds, Coin of Gold or Silver, to him in hand paid
by the said Arthur Applewhite before the sealing & Delivering
of these presents the Receipt Whereof the said Hardy Harris
and Ann his wife Both hereby Acknowledge Hath granted
Bargained and sold and doth by these presents Grant bargain
and sell unto the said Arthur Applewhite his heirs &
assigns forever, a Certain tract or parcel of Land Lying & being
in Southampton County, On the south side of the three
creeks Containing by Estimation Two hundred & twenty
Acres be the same more or less Beginning at the run of
the said Creek, and bounded on the East and South side,
by Timothy Thorpe's line, and on the west side, by Amos
Harris's line, and on the North by the run of the said three
creeks, with the Reversion, & Reversions, Remainder and
Remainders unto Issues and Profits thereof, and also all
the Estate right Title Interest Claim and Demand
Whatsoever, of him the said Hardy Harris Ann his wife
and their Heirs of in or to the same or any part thereof
To have and to hold the said Land & premises
With all and singular the Appurtenances thereunto
Belonging unto the said Arthur Applewhite his heirs
and assigns forever To the only Proper use and behoof of the said
Arthur Applewhite his heirs and assigns forever, and the
said Hardy Harris and Ann his wife for themselves & their
Heirs Executors Administrators or assigns doth Covenant
