 James Wright and to his heirs and assigns forever but
 having a little before his death expressed and earnest
 desire that his Will should not be proved but that his
 children should nevertheless faithfully comply with
 and fulfill the contents thereof Now this -
 Indenture Witnesseth that we the said
 David Wright and Sarah his wife for and in consid-
 eration of the request of our Father the aforesaid Job Wright
 and that we may fully comply with the terms of the
 aforesaid last will and Testament and also for and
 in consideration of the just and full sum of five shillings
 current Money of Virginia by the said James Wright to us
 in hand paid before the executing and delivery of these
 Presents the receipt Whereof we do hereby acknowledge
 and thereof acquit and discharge the said James Wright
 his heirs and assigns forever and ourselves hereunto fully
