also bound as his security And Whereas the said James Wilson  
Coher being willing to indemnify and save harmless the said  
James Butts Calthrop by means of such securityship their  
presents therefore Witness in Consideration of the premises  
aforesaid that I the said James Wilson Coher for myself  
my heirs executors & assigns do hereby promise covenant  
Grant and agree to and with the said James Butts Calthrop  
his heirs assigns that the within Indentured & every thing  
therein contained shall be deemed stands & be taken to operate  
to indemnify and save harmless the said James Butts  
Calthrop
