Brown for and in Consideration of the sum of ten pounds Current
 Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said James Brown
 The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to be fully satisfied
 and Paid hath granted bargained and sold and doth by these
 Presents Grant bargain and sell unto the said James Brown
 his Heirs &c a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing by
 estimation fifty acres be the same more or less and Situate in the County
 of Southampton aforesaid bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at
 a lightwood post then along a line of marked Trees to a Gum in
 the Cypress Swamp then up the various Courses of the run of
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
