aforesaid slaves goods & Chattels & with the money arising
Thereof retain pay and satisfy the aforesaid sum of fifty
pounds and the Interest arising from the date hereof & the
charges attending such sale, and the drawing & recording this
Indenture to the said Richard Kello his heirs or assigns, and
all overplus the said Richard Kello his heirs Executors
doth hereby covenant promise and Grant to pay or cause to be
paid unto the said Stephen Summrell his heirs Executors
or assigns or his or their Order In Witness whereof the parties
