released & delivered & Confirmed & by these Presents both Grant
& Bargain sell alien enfeoff release & deliver & confirm unto the said
John Williams & to his Heirs & Assigns forever, All that Messuages
Tract & Parcel of Land whereon the said John Bowers now lives, situate
lying & being in the County of Southampton and Parish of Netterway
Aforesaid, containing by Estimation one hundred & Twenty five
acres be the same more or less And being all that plantation
Messuages Tract & Parcel of Land which the said John Bowers
lately bought of John Cherry (& others) by Indenture bearing
Date on or about November one thousand seven hundred & Eighty
Three And Bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a
Pier on the short bridge swamp in the said John Williams line
and thence his said line to a pine a corner tree of the said Land
standing in the line of another Tract or part of the said John Williams
line or in settling Councils. Thence said line to another pine in
David Turners line Thence the said Turners line to the aforesaid
