Whereas Robert Jory Arney his wife have by their Certain
Indenture bearing Date the 16th Day of October in the year
of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & eighty four sold &
conveyed unto John Williamson the fee simple Estate of One
One Certain tract or Parcel of Land lying & being in the County
of Southampton containing Two hundred & fifteen acres
more or less And whereas the said Arney cannot conveniently
travel to our Court of our County of Southampton to
make Acknowledgement of the said Conveyance; Therefore
we do give unto you or any two or more of you power to
Receive the Acknowledgement which the said Arneys shall be
willing to make before you of the Conveyance aforesaid
Contained in the said Indenture which is herewith annexed &
we ~~will~~ ^{do} therefore ^{you} Command ^{you} personally to go to the said Arney
and Receive her Acknowledgement of the same & Examine her
Privily & apart from her husband Whether she doth the
same Voluntarily without his persuasion or threats ^{whether} & she
be willing the same should be recorded in the Court of our
said County and when you have received her Acknowledg-
ment and Examined her as aforesaid that you testifiably &
