year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty, baires -
Between William Little of the County of Southampton of the
One part and William Blent of the same County, of the other
Part Witnesseth, that the said William Little for and
in consideration of the sum of Thirty pounds current money of
Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Blent
Before the Ensealing & Delivery thereof, The receipt whereof
he doth hereby Acknowledge & himself fully satisfied and
Paid hath given granted bargained sold aliened impleased
confirmed and by these presents doth for himself his heirs
heirs admors &c. &c. give fully freely & absolutely give
Grant Bargain sell alien implead release Convey & fully
confirm unto the said William Blent his heirs Executors, Admins
and Assigns forever, One certain Tract or parcel of Land
situate Lying & being on the North side of Meherrin River in
the County of Southampton containing by Estimation
Thirty Acres be the same more or less and bounded as
Followeth Beginning, at a Maple in Persons Swamp the said
Little's upper Corner, Thence along the said Little's line, to his Corner,
Spanish Oak, Thence along a line of Marked Trees, to the said
Little's lower Corner, Maple in the said Persons Swamp adjacent
Thence up the run of the said Swamp to the Beginning To have
and to hold, and peaceably to enjoy the aforesaid Thirty
Acres of Land from the claim Right Title of me William Little
my heirs Executors admors or any other persons or persons Whatsoever
To the only use & behoof of him the said William Blent his
heirs & assigns forever; with all works, ways, under works, &c.
